

Introduction:

DCLG and iNetwork hosted 8 regional events entitled 'Think Cyber - Think Resilience'. Each of these events aimed to raise awareness about cyber related issues with senior officers from Local Authorities and their strategic partners.

Each of the events included presentations from Government agencies involved in aspects of cybersecurity or cyber resilience, and workshops to explore specific matters in more detail. The Government agencies being: CESG, CERT-UK, TNA and GDS.

The agenda was amended after the first event - to reflect learning from that event. This changes created the opportunity to invite the relevant Regional Cyber Crime Unit to take part in workshops at the events.

The presentations have, to an extent, evolved after each event - again reflecting on the lessons learnt from previous events. Generic versions of the presentations have been created to share with those who attended the events - and more widely. These generic presentations are as follows:

- Local Cyber Storyboard - not used at the events but included here as background to the 'Think Cyber - Think Resilience' programme
- DCLG Think Cyber - Think Resilience Overview - used to introduce the day in the opening plenary session
- CESG Cyber Threats - also used in opening plenary sessions and outlines the scope of cyber threats to UK government
- CiSP Leaflet - for operational reasons we cannot share the CERT-UK presentations but the need to join CiSP as the focus of their plenary session presentation
- TNA Introduction - outlined the role of the National Archives and the support they offer to Senior Information Risk Owners
- GDS PSN & SNAP - used in workshop sessions to facilitate discussion with GDS about current and developing national infrastructure
- CESG Ten Steps - used in workshop sessions to facilitate discussions with CESG on the Ten-Steps to cyber resilience
- TNA SIRO - used on workshop sessions to facilitate discussions with TNA about the role of SIRO in local government and how TNA can support LA Information Risk Owners
- CiSP Application - used in workshop sessions with CERT-UK to help attendees to understand the CiSP sign-up process

- RCCU Presentations - each of the Regional Cyber Crime Units had their own take on the national strategy for cybercrime and copies of their respective presentations are enclosed
- DCLG Next Steps - used in the closing plenary session to outline actions either underway or being planned
